

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

For the

2000 AIAA/AAAE/ACC JAY HOLLINGSWORTH SPEAS AIRPORT AWARD

This award honors the person or persons judged to have contributed most outstandingly during the recent past toward achieving compatible relationships between airports and/or heliports and their surrounding environments. Such improvements might be in any one of the following areas:

- Airport land use compatibility plans and control
- Aircraft noise reduction or abatement activities
- Promotion/encouragement of public participation in efforts to improve environmental quality
- Protection of environmental critical resources
- Architecture, landscaping, or other design considerations to improve compatibility of airports and their communities
- Education, public relations, or institutional programs promoting an improved environment

The nomination package should include a nomination form and respond to the following questions regarding the event, activity, or accomplishment:

- Is it reasonably current and on-going?
- Does it have practical application and significance in other than a specific local situation?
- Was it accomplished or conducted as part of the nominee's regular employment or vocation, or was it "over and above" normal duties?
- What are the ways in which it has furthered the cause of improved environmental quality?
- Did its success result in a publication, patent, award, or similar recognition?

The complete nomination package should not exceed 10 pages. The recipient will receive a certificate and a \$7,500 honorarium. The presentation of the award will be made at the 2000 AAAE/ACC Planning, Design, and Construction Symposium, scheduled for 5-7 April 2000 in Reno, Nevada.

Deadline for submission of nominations is 1 January 2000.
